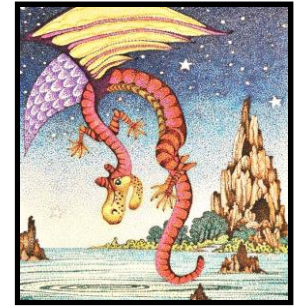




# “Home Brewed Fantasy”

***An Open Show with two age groups, 13- to 19-year-olds & 20-year-olds to 100.***

Heroes to Horrors: A comic book, cartoon, and anime inspired show meant to bring out the inner kid in every artist. Bring out your original monster sculptures, your fan art, your old tabletop RPG character sketches! Anything you’d like as long as it comes from your imagination.

**ARTIST ELIGIBILITY AND FEES:**

This show is open to both Displaying and General (Non-displaying) members of the New Braunfels Art League (NBAL) as well as Non-Member (visiting artists). The entry fees are to be paid when you bring in your entries.

**ENTRY FEES: (Maximum of 3 entries)**

13-to 19-years old		20-to 100- year-old	
One (1) Entry .....	FREE	One (1) Entry .....	\$25

**NOTE:** You must **pay** the entry fees with **cash** or **check only**. **You do not have to be a member of NBAL to enter this show.** If you want to become a member of NBAL, you may fill out an NBAL Membership Form and pay the annual dues of \$40 at the submission desk. This is done separately from the Entry Fees and must be separate checks. As a General Member you will receive monthly newsletters and be allowed to enter any future shows for the rest of the year. This does not allow you to display in the Main Gallery, which happens through our Jury Process. **NBAL retains a 25% commission on all sales.**

## **CATEGORIES:**

<b>1</b>	<b>Painting, Photography and Digital Media</b> – Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Gouache, Tempera, Inks applied with brushes or poured. Photographs and artwork created by use of a computer. <b>Any Mixed Media with painting or digital as the dominant media.</b>
<b>2</b>	<b>Drawing Media</b> - Pastel, Charcoal, Conté, Colored Pencil, Graphite, Scratchboard, Collage, Handmade Prints, Inks applied with pen or markers. <b>Any Mixed Media with Drawing Media as the dominant media.</b>
<b>3</b>	<b>3-Dimensional Media</b> – Ceramics/Pottery, Metals, Jewelry, Enameling, Glass, Stone, Wood, Textiles, Found Objects and Mosaics. <b>Any Mixed Media or Mosaics should be placed with overall dominant media.</b>

## **GUIDELINES & RULES:**

- A.** Only **ORIGINAL** works of art will be accepted in Special Shows. If working from photographs, the photographs used cannot infringe on copyrights.
- B.** NBAL has authority to decline unacceptable works based on NBAL Gallery Rules, Section 7, which may be found on the NBAL website. Refusal of work will be decided by Special Show Chairpersons, Submission Team Leader, and 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President.
- C.** There will be **no** early submissions! If you cannot be there on the submission day, you will need to have someone submit your artwork on your behalf.
- D.** **Two-dimensional work** must be properly framed, unless it is a gallery wrap canvas that is 1¼ “deep or more; any gallery wrap of shallower depth must be framed. **All work MUST be equipped for hanging** with sturdy hanging wire and must not weigh more than 15 lbs. No saw-toothed hangers, loop hangers, clips or plastic box frames will be allowed. Display area for all entries added together will not exceed 150 inches total. No single piece of artwork larger than 84 total inches will be allowed. Measurement of all 2D artwork is height plus width (H+W) of outside edge of frames. If glass is needed on an artwork, Plexiglas is required on works larger than 16X20. Pastel and charcoal works are exempted from this Plexiglas requirement.
- E.** **Three-dimensional work must be ready for display.** Display area for all entries added together will not exceed 150 inches total. No single piece of artwork larger than 84 total inches will be allowed. Measurement of all 3D artwork is width plus depth (W+D) of outside edges of the art piece.
- F.** **You must leave your work in the gallery for the entire length of the show. Failure to do so could result in exclusion from future shows.**
- G.** **Items sold in any show may be replaced with comparable artwork as soon as possible.** Replacement work may have been previously shown in the Main Gallery but must meet all other eligibility requirements as stated.

### **13-to 19-years old**

- H.** Teens may choose to have the artwork entered for sale or specify that it is “Not For Sale” (NFS).
- I.** Teens may submit unframed artwork, but it must be matted and does not require a hanger.
- J.** **Teachers or Parents will need to be present while submit student work.**

### **20-to 100- year-old**

- K.** **ALL artwork entered MUST be for sale.**
- L.** Entries must be the original work of the artist and **not previously exhibited in any NBAL Special Shows** or in the NBAL Main Gallery.
- M.** **NBAL General Members (Non-displaying) who enter work in this show are required to work one full day of NBAL’s choosing during the show month, OR they may pay a fee of \$30 extra on Submission Day to not work.** There will be someone present at check-in to schedule your workday. **NBAL Displaying Members must work their normal workday.**
