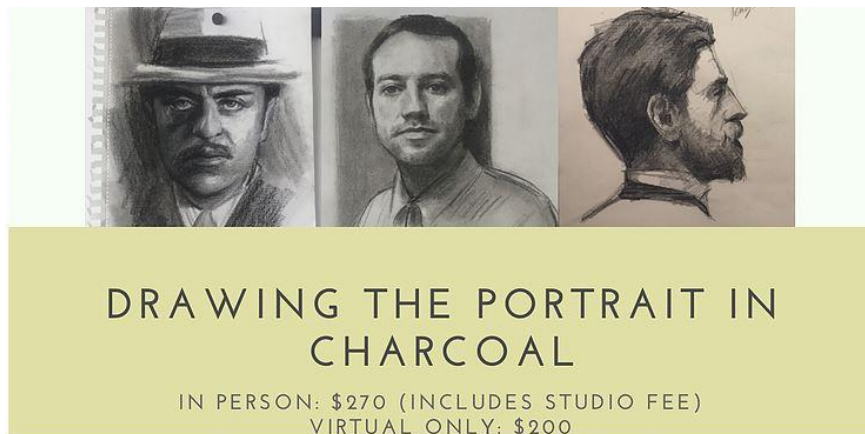

The description: “Tools and techniques will be taught for using charcoal to develop a compelling and accurate portrait. We will learn step-by-step how to set up and develop a head, capture the light and shadow, check and correct mistakes, and achieve a likeness, working from life and photos. Each class will begin with a talk and demonstration, teaching a new concept, and then one-on-one critiques and help will be given through the rest of the class, as each student works on their own pieces.”
