ARTIST ELIGIBILITY AND FEES:

This show is open to middle and high school students from Comal ISD Schools, New Braunfels ISD Schools, private schools and Comal County or New Braunfels Home Schools.

Student art is to be delivered and picked up by Middle School/High School Teachers or Home School Parents.

There are NO Entry Fees.

NBAL retains a 10% commission on all sales (if students choose to sell their work).

AWARDS:

Best of Show for Middle School = \$100 w/ribbon Best of Show for High School = \$100 w/ribbon Three (3) CATEGORIES (Each Category awarded)

First Place = \$75 w/ribbon Second Place = \$50 w/ribbon Third Place = \$25 w/ribbon Honorable Mention = \$10 w/ribbon

The decision of the judge is final.

LIABILITY: Although the NBAL Art Gallery will exercise due care in handling works submitted, the New Braunfels Art League, including any member acting on its behalf, is NOT responsible for any loss or damage to any work of art.

GUIDELINES & RULES:

- **A.** You must be **in Middle School or High School** to enter this show.
- **B.** Only **ORIGINAL works of art** will be accepted in Special Shows. If working from photographs, <u>the photographs</u> used cannot infringe on copyrights.
- C. Students may choose to have the artwork entered for sale.
- D. Two-dimensional work must be properly framed or matted, unless it is a gallery wrap canvas at least 1-1/4" deep. All work MUST be equipped for hanging with sturdy hanging wire and must not weigh more than 15 lbs. No saw-tooth hangers, loop hangers, clips or plastic box frames will be allowed. Matted artwork without a frame does not require a hanger. Artwork must not be larger than 84 inches (width + length). 3D artwork is measured width plus depth of outside edges. If glass is needed on an artwork, Plexiglas is required on works larger than 16X20. Pastel and charcoal works are exempted from this Plexiglas requirement.
- E. Three-dimensional work must be ready for display.
- F. Teachers or home school parents will need to submit student work.
- G. You must leave your work in the gallery for the entire length of the show.

	Inks applied with pen or markers. Any Mixed Media with Drawing Media as the dominant media.				
2	3-Dimensional Media – Ceramics/Pottery, Metals, Jewelry, Enameling, Glass, Stone, Wood, Textiles, Found				
3	Objects and Mosaics. Any Mixed Media or Mosaics should be placed with overall dominant media.

Submission Date: March 4 @ 10 am - 2 pm & Pick-up Date: March 26 @ 12 pm - 5 pm

Preparing Artist Paperwork and Artwork for show:

- 1. One piece of art accepted per student.
- 2. Students' 2D artwork should be matted and/or framed and have the <u>Art Label</u> attached to the lower left corner of the artwork; 3D artwork should be ready for display and have the <u>Art Label</u> attached to the bottom.
- 3. Please be sure that ALL information is filled out on the Art Label.
- 4. Please be sure that all the contact information is completed on the <u>Artist Inventory Log Sheet</u>. Teacher/home school parent's information must be included on the Artist Inventory Log Sheet.
- 5. If the artist is younger than 18, then we need a signature from parent or guardian.
- 6. We need three copies of this form, all of which will be initialed upon submission. One will be returned to the teacher/home school parent and two for NBAL (one for the sales desk and one for the Bookkeeper's office).

Check-in:

- 1. Teacher/home school parent will bring students' artwork with Art Labels attached.
- Teacher/home school parent will bring 3 copies of <u>Artist Inventory Log Sheets</u> per student -- one for sales desk, one for bookkeeper, one for teacher/home school parent.
- 3. NBAL will check that the 2D artwork is properly matted and/or framed and has the <u>Art Label</u> attached to the lower left side of the artwork, the 3D artwork is ready for display with the <u>Art Label</u> attached to the bottom, and that each entry has the Artist Number (assigned at check-in) and category number on all forms.
- 4. The NBAL Submission Team member who is doing the check-in should initial all copies of the <u>Artist Inventory</u> <u>Sheets</u> in the lower right side of form where indicated, return the teacher/home school parent's copy back to them for their records and keep two copies for the gallery.
- 5. The Artist # will be assigned during the check-in process.
- 6. NBAL Submission Team will take in the artwork and the paperwork and prepare the gallery for displaying.

Pick-up:

1. Teacher/home school parent must pick up all unsold artwork and sign each <u>Artist Inventory Log Sheet</u> as well as the Teacher/Home School Parent Pick-up Log where indicated on the designated pick-up date.
