Also purchases the Desk Calendar, Brown Craft Paper, Bubble Wrap, Masking Tape, Packing Tape, Small and Large Shopping Bags, Small and Large Jewelry Boxes and Stamps. Makes sure the thank you notes have envelopes and get mailed. The Gallery Assistant should come into the gallery once a week to check on everything and restock items as needed. Please remember that docents do NOT have electrical access at the docent desk. The electrical wiring for our phone and credit card machine run through the basement and the wiring is very fragile. Constant tugging on the wires at the desk will result in a break in the circuit and we will lose credit card/phone service. Docents need to access the electrical outlets along the walls.

Similarly, the IPOD setup in the workroom should not be disturbed. If you need to charge personal devices, please bring your own charging cords. Unplugging the IPOD results in a loss of the SONOS signal.

#### **Note to all NBAL Members**

OCTOBER 1 started our membership drive for next year.

Be sure to use the form titled **NBAL MEMBERSHIP FORM 2023.** 

REPEATED Instructions for scheduling workdays for 2023 in case you missed them:

- 1. 2023 NBAL Memberships will be taken starting OCTOBER 1 through DECEMBER 31 of 2022.
- 2. If you like your docent workday or the team position you are on and you want the same workday/position next year, then you must pay your fees by NOVEMBER 26 to hold those workdays/positions. Please write in your 1<sup>st</sup> choice on the bottom of the membership form for the workday/team you are on and want to stay on.
- 3. If you do not like the workday/team position that you are on now and you want to change it for next year, then you will need to pay your fees by NOVEMBER 26 and write in your 1<sup>st</sup> choice and a 2<sup>nd</sup> choice along with <u>CHANGE</u> next to them on the membership form. I will do my best to work with you to make it happen. Please keep in mind that I cannot put you on a day that is already fully staffed, but I will make the change for you if an opening comes up. (Example: If you want 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday and a 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday docent does not pay by Nov.26, then you will get their spot.)
- 4. IF YOU DO NOT PAY YOUR MEMBERSHIP AND DISPLAY FEES BY NOVEMBER 26 THEN YOUR DOCENT WORKDAY/TEAM POSITON WILL BE OFFERED TO THE NEW JURIED MEMBERS COMING IN ON DECEMBER 3.
- 5. After the new juried displaying members are placed, the open slots then become first paid, first placed.
- 6. If you pay after November 26 then please be sure to mark 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> choice at the bottom of the membership form and I will do my best to place you there. NO GUARANTEES!

PLEASE PAY ALL NBAL FEES BY NOVEMBER 26, by doing so you will help us to create the work schedules and calendars needed to run the gallery efficiently.
