Gallery Staffing

Instructions for scheduling workdays for 2023:

- 1. 2023 NBAL Memberships will be taken starting OCTOBER 1 through DECEMBER 31 of 2022.
- 2. If you like your docent workday or the team position you are on and you want the same workday/position next year, then you must pay your fees by NOVEMBER 26 to hold those workdays/positions. Please write in your 1st choice on the bottom of the membership form for the workday/team you are on and want to stay on.
- 3. If you do not like the workday/team position that you are on now and you want to change it for next year, then you will need to pay your fees by NOVEMBER 26 and write in your 1st choice and a 2nd choice along with <u>CHANGE</u> next to them on the membership form. I will do my best to work with you to make it happen. Please keep in mind that I cannot put you on a day that is already fully staffed, but I will make the change for you if an opening comes up. (Example: If you want 1st Wednesday and a 1st Wednesday docent does not pay by Nov.26, then you will get their spot.)

- 4. IF YOU DO NOT PAY YOUR MEMBERSHIP AND DISPLAY FEES BY NOVEMBER 26 THEN YOUR DOCENT WORKDAY/TEAM POSITON WILL BE OFFERED TO THE NEW JURIED MEMBERS COMING IN ON DECEMBER 3.
- 5. After the new juried displaying members are placed, the open slots then become first paid, first placed.
- 6. If you pay after November 26, then please be sure to mark 1st and 2nd choice at the bottom of the membership form and I will do my best to place you there. NO GUARANTEES!

PLEASE PAY ALL NBAL FEES BY NOVEMBER 26. By doing so, you will help us to create the work schedules and calendars needed to run the gallery efficiently.

Recommended Constitution Bylaw Changes

NBAL Executive Board is recommending the following bylaw changes. The proposed changes will be voted on at the Tuesday, September 20, 2:00 pm general membership meeting. Refer to the 2022 Yearbook for the current policies.

ARTICLE II: MEETINGS

<u>Section 4</u>: Voting by E-Mail (Electronic) may be used by the Executive Board as outlined in the Gallery Rules, when necessary, between scheduled board meetings.

Article V: JOB RESPONSIBILITIES OF OFFICERS

<u>Section1</u>: Duties of the Executive Board will be to conduct all business of NBAL. The Executive Board is responsible for filling all vacancies that occur.

- a. First Vice President presides in the absence of the President. Manages and oversees the running of the NBAL Gallery. Provides leadership in facilitating gallery staffing, and docent training sessions. Works to maintain and keep gallery desk information, rules and instruction sheets up to date. Monitors the overall appearance of the gallery, and docent work areas. Oversees scheduling and planning for any special events to take place within the gallery. Promotes sales by presenting the art in an organized manner, using attractive displays and merchandising methods.
- f. Assistant Treasurer assists Treasurer in receiving monies due to organization, assists with posting QuickBooks. Assist in training members that are new to posting QuickBooks. Attends monthly Executive Board, Team Board and General meetings. Assist Treasurer, President and other Board members as needed.
- g. Secretary records minutes from all Board meetings, Team meetings, and general meetings and forwards them to appropriate parties for review and correction prior to the following monthly meetings. Ensures the final versions of all approved minutes are properly maintained in the designated area. Writes correspondence as needed. Oversees the Library Team Leader position.
- h. Parliamentarian enforces Robert's Rules of Order at all meetings; keeps an up-to-date copy of the Constitution and Bylaws governing NBAL. Oversees revisions of the Constitution, Bylaws and Gallery Rules of NBAL. Serves as Chairperson of the Nominating Committee. Oversees the NBAL contact with the Chamber of Commerce

and the Greater New Braunfels Art Council. Monitors the upkeep of the NBAL scrapbook. The Parliamentarian works with the Membership Team Leader to proof and correct changes and information to be printed in the NBAL Yearbook.
